Despite its importance, total giving

4 out of 5 respondents to an Alliance

toward climate change accounted for <u>only 2%</u> of overall giving in 2020.

Recently, funders have dramatically increased their contributions toward addressing the climate crisis.

<u>Magazine survey</u> predicted that climate change would be the dominant issue in philanthropy in the next 25 years.
