regulating the lowest hourly wage employers must pay employees











OPEN BORDERS

legislation and policies that enable free movement of people











PLANT-BASED FOOD SYSTEMS

food systems that exclude or minimize reliance on animal products











STRONG LOCAL GOVERNMENT

local government has authority, resources, and autonomy to effectively address the needs and priorities of citizens









UNIVERSAL HEALTHCARE

a system that ensures all people have access to the medical services they need









ACCESSIBLE JUSTICE SYSTEM

fair, transparent, and unbiased law and order systems for all











AFFORDABLE HOUSING

housing accessible to people with a household income at or below the median











UNIVERSAL BASIC INCOME

all citizens receive a regular and unconditional payment from the government to support their livelihood









CARBON CREDITS

certificates representing the right to emit a specific amount of carbon dioxide









CITIZEN-FORWARD SOCIAL MEDIA

people-driven social media designed to strengthen cooperation and connection









CIVIC PARTICIPATION

enabling broad engagement in key decision-making processes











ACCESSIBLE PUBLIC TRANSIT

ensuring equitable access to using and navigating public transport









CLEAN WATER INFRASTRUCTURE

infrastructure to treat and deliver clean drinking water









CLEAR PATHWAYS TO CITIZENSHIP

immigration policies that lay out a well-defined and fair process for obtaining citizenship of a country









CO-OPERATIVE BUSINESS MODELS

member-owned enterprises that prioritize social and economic benefits over maximizing profit









COMMUNITY ACTION

communities are empowered and supported to create interventions around issues that matter to them











COMMUNITY HEALTH NETWORKS

an interconnected group of healthcare providers delivering coordinated and accessible care to the local population











CULTURAL PRESERVATION

efforts to document, revitalize, and protect valuable cultural practices and heritage from decline or extinction









DECOLONIZED WEALTH

a deliberate reversal of problematic colonial and capitalistic dynamics







DEGROWTH MOVEMENT

a shift from maximizing economic output to improving human wellbeing and ecological sustainability











DEMILITARIZATION

reducing or withdrawing military presence













DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

systems and processes that allow for anticipation of and protection from natural disasters, pandemics, or other large scale emergencies











EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

investment in and support for robust and accessible learning for all children from birth until primary school









ECO-BANKING

banking with institutions that do not fund fossil fuels or other non-renewable resources









ELECTRIC VEHICLES

battery-powered modes of transportation







ENDANGERED SPECIES PRESERVATION

conservation efforts to protect and recover plant and animal species at risk of extinction







ENVIRONMENTALLY SUSTAINABLE AI

green AI systems that rely on environmentally-friendly resources for development and use









EQUITABLE ACCESS TO CELL PHONES

providing everyone the ability to afford, obtain, and use cell phones











EQUITABLE PUBLIC EDUCATION SYSTEM

resources and support provided to all children to help them develop to their full academic and social potential









FOOD CROP DIVERSITY

producing and consuming a greater variety of staple crops









FREE AND NORMALIZED BIRTH CONTROL

empowering individuals in their reproductive choices by providing readily available, affordable birth control methods





FREEDOM OF RELIGION

the right to choose and practice one's religion without interference









FREEDOM OF THE PRESS

the right of journalists and media to report without being controlled or censored by the government







HUMAN-CENTERED AI

AI systems that augment rather than displace human abilities, with a special focus on not inheriting or amplifying biases











INCOME MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS

government initiatives that provide monetary assistance to people with insufficient or no income







INDIGENOUS LIVELIHOODS

supporting traditional livelihood practices including hunting, fishing, gathering, and pastoralism









INTENTIONAL COMMUNITY LIVING

multigenerational residential communities where people live together guided by a shared vision, values, and collective purpose





JUST ENERGY TRANSITION BUSINESS MODELS

prioritizing clean energy across industries while ensuring an equitable transition for workers









LANGUAGE PRESERVATION

efforts to document, revitalize, and protect languages from decline or extinction









LIBRARIES

free, universal access to spaces and institutions that provide reading resources and community services









MARRIAGE

a legally and socially recognized union between two individuals, giving them full rights and benefits





MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT

strong mental wellbeing support systems integrated into home, school, and work







MUSEUMS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE CENTERS

preserving and exhibiting art, history, and anthropology for public education and engagement







NATIONAL PARKS

land designated by the government for nature, wildlife, and geological preservation.











NATIVE AND ANCESTRAL LANDBACK MOVEMENT

indigenous-led movement that seeks to return ancestral territories









NON-VIOLENT POLICE FORCE ALTERNATIVES

eliminating the use of violent police tactics and giving communities a diverse set of tools with which to respond to crises











OCEAN STEWARDSHIP

responsible use and protection of the ocean and its resources











OPEN ACCESS TO UNBIASED INFORMATION

facilitating free and unrestricted availability of factual, objective information without commercial or ideological influence





PAID FAMILY LEAVE

providing paid time off for parents and caregivers to care for children, new babies or ill family members





PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

widely available recreation and green spaces









PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING SYSTEMS

processes in which community members shape and decide how to spend public budgets







PEOPLE-CENTERED INTERNET

internet as a force for good, improving lives and wellbeing of people









PROGRESSIVE TAXES

tax rate proportional to income









PROTECTION OF BIODIVERSITY

conservation efforts aimed at safeguarding the diversity of life on Earth





PROTECTIONS FOR FACTORY WORKERS

codifying minimum wage, safe working conditions, and basic housing standards for factory workers









PROTECTIONS FOR FARMWORKERS

codifying minimum wage, safe working conditions, and basic housing standards for farmworkers







PUBLIC ACCESS TO GREEN SPACE

providing easy access to parks, gardens, and undeveloped natural spaces









PUBLIC FUNDING FOR THE ARTS

government support for artistic endeavors and cultural enrichment





PUBLIC SAFETY

community-rooted and focused policing and emergency services









BARRIER-FREE PUBLIC SPACE

barrier-free access to public spaces









PUBLIC WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT

collection, treatment, and disposal of sewage











PUBLICLY-FUNDED INTERNET

government-supported initiatives to promote internet access for all











RECYCLING INFRASTRUCTURE

investment in recycling infrastructure for new materials and e-waste





REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE

public and private support for faming approaches that focus on restoring soil and ecosystem health to enhance biodiversity, mitigate climate change and address inequity







REGULATED STOCK MARKET

government oversight of the marketplace for buying and selling securities (stocks and bonds) to ensure fairness, transparency, and investor protection









REPARATIONS

financial compensation for past injustices and their lasting effects









RESPECT FOR AND HONOR OF ELDERS

care and respect towards older individuals due to their wisdom and experience is elevated to a societal value









ROBUST PUBLIC HEALTH RESEARCH

cutting edge, high-quality research to improve public health outcomes for all









SAFEGUARDS AGAINST SOCIAL MEDIA MISINFORMATION

consumer awareness initiatives, platform efforts, and regulations to promote the proliferation of facts









SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

investment in evidence-based scientific research and its dissemination









SIMPLIFYING BUREACRACY

making public services easier to access and understand for all









SMALL BUSINESS E-COMMERCE SUCCESS

small businesses can easily access and effectively use e-commerce platforms









SMALL BUSINESS FUNDING

substantial government assistance to help establish, run, and expand small businesses









SOLAR PANELS

widespread use of devices that convert sunlight into electricity









SOLID WASTE TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL

process of handling unwanted solid materials post-utility









SPORTS CULTURE

elevating participation in and perception of sports to the level of values and traditions









STRONG SECOND-HAND ECONOMY

a vibrant and efficient economy for second-hand goods comprises a large portion of the market









SUPPORT FOR CHILD FOSTERING AND ADOPTION

financial incentives and assistance for raising a foster or adopted child





SUSTAINABLE CLOTHING SYSTEMS

creating and distributing clothes with minimal negative environmental and social impact











SUSTAINABLE URBAN PLANNING

inclusive urban development with mixed-use spaces and eco-friendly design











TRUST IN STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT

public confidence in institutions and leaders









URBAN AGRICULTURE

cultivating, processing, and distributing food in urban settings









FLEXIBLE FAMILY STRUCTURES

acceptance and codification of family structures outside of the traditional model









VOTING RIGHTS PROTECTIONS

ensuring all voters are able to participate in public elections fairly, without barriers or discrimination









WIND FARMS

proliferating turbines that use wind power to generate electricity









WORKERS' RIGHTS

legal measures related to labor rights, including salary standards, working conditions, safety and protections against discrimination







WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

investment in and incentive for professional and skilled trade education









WORKPLACE WELLBEING

a shift from a culture of overwork and burnout to greater work-life balance







YOUTH LEADERSHIP

supporting young people in developing and exercising skills to defend their interests and guide society towards positive change
